How Instructors Indicate Important Ideas

Every instructor provides clues to important ideas and clarifying details in lectures, intentionally and unintentionally. When you become aware of these clues, they can help you determine what to write down and learn.

Below is a checklist of common methods instructors indicate main ideas and related details in lectures. Use this list to decode each of your instructors as each one indicates to you what is important to write down and learn. <input type="checkbox"/>	Asks questions on a topic
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spends more time on important ideas
<input type="checkbox"/>	Provides visual aids- overheads, slides, films, videos
<input type="checkbox"/>	Points out material information in lecture that is also in the textbook
<input type="checkbox"/>	Presents information in form of lists- First, second, third, or 1,2,3, etc.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Performs a demonstration or experiment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Has the class break into groups to work on a specific project.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Brings in a speaker
<input type="checkbox"/>	Voice emphasizes important information- louder/softer, higher/lower, faster slower
<input type="checkbox"/>	Presents details in form of steps, stages, phases
<input type="checkbox"/>	Compares or contrasts ideas or events
<input type="checkbox"/>	Assigns outside reading or supplemental readings on special topics
