The Geospatial Technology Center at CPCC is proud to present the “College Faculty Training in Geospatial Education” initiative funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and the National Geospatial Technology Center of Excellence (NGTCe).

College/University faculty have the opportunity to participate in this program to teach and disseminate geospatial education across their college curriculum increasing students awareness of, and allowing them to embrace, technology that will help them better understand the world around them.

This program will begin in the summer 2009 and last until spring 2010. During that time faculty will complete two Continuing Educational courses and develop a geospatial related exercise to use in the classroom. The two Continuing Education courses will consist of a two day “in person” training session with the remaining course work being completed online.

For their efforts in developing a classroom exercise and for finishing the two courses, each faculty member will be paid an \$800.00 stipend (\$400.00 for each completed course).
