Collision Repair and Refinishing Technology Painting and Refinishing (C60130-C1)

This pathway focuses on preparation for a career as an auto body painting and refinishing technician. Students can choose to pair this course with the remaining courses in the Collision Repair and Refinishing diploma program. The job outlook for this field is positive. Many local repair shops hire students, full- and part-time, from the CPCC cooperative learning program upon completion of the diploma.

- To be eligible for enrollment, a high school student must meet the following criteria:
 - Be a high school junior or senior;
 - Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 on high school courses or have the recommendation of the high school principal
 - Meet the prerequisites for the career pathway.
- To maintain eligibility for continued enrollment, a student must
 - Continue to make progress toward high school graduation
 - Maintain a 2.0 in college coursework after completing two courses.
- Upon satisfactory completion of the pathway, students may be awarded the Criminal Justice Technology Certificate Specialization in Basics of Criminal Justice.
