- To be eligible for enrollment, a high school student must meet the following criteria:
 - Be a high school junior or senior;
 - Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 on high school courses or have the recommendation of the high school principal
 - Meet the prerequisites for the career pathway.
- To maintain eligibility for continued enrollment, a student must
 - Continue to make progress toward high school graduation
 - Maintain a 2.0 in college coursework after completing two courses.
- Upon satisfactory completion of the pathway, students may be awarded the Business Administration Certificate Specialization in Business Operations.
