



## Minimum Course Requirement

### CPCC Advisement Check Sheet

Students who do not meet freshman admissions requirements to a four-year North Carolina college or university (based on high school grades, courses, or test scores) must complete a minimum of 24 or 30 transferable credits in specific courses to qualify for transfer admission. The credits must include two college-level courses in each of the following subjects: English, math, social science, and natural science. Students who completed high school in 2004 or beyond must also complete two foreign language courses.
