Strategic Master Plan

I. Mission

To support the mission and educational purpose of Central Piedmont Community College by generating revenues through business related activities and projects.

II. Structure of Organization

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. The number of voting directors of the corporation shall not be less than seven (7) or more than fifteen (15). The officers of the corporation are the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Chief Executive Officer, Secretary-Treasurer.

I. Corporate Activity Approval Process

A. Project Criteria Review

1. All proposed projects must benefit CPCC and be in compliance with the mission of the CPCC Services Corporation.
2. All proposals should include an appropriate business plan for review by the CEO.

B. Request for Project Approval

3. All projects must be submitted in writing to the CEO for review (use the corporate format).
4. Favorably reviewed projects will be forwarded to the directors for formal consideration.

C. Budget Adoption

1. All approved activities and projects requiring financial support must be adopted in the corporate budget.
