[ProQuest Nursing Journals](#) : More than 250 leading full-text journals in nursing and allied health.

[Nursing Resource Center](#) : Search through millions of pages of content including animated depictions of human anatomy, encyclopedias, diseases and conditions.

Health related databases within EBSCOhost:

[Health Source: Nursing/Academic edition](#) : Provides more than 400 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines, and provides abstracts and indexing for over 500 journals. Also includes integrated results from Clinical Pharmacology and access to Stedman's Medical Dictionary.

[CINAHL](#): Covers nursing, biomedicine, health sciences librarianship, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines. It indexes 2,717 journals and provides full text for 320 journals.

[PsycInfo](#): From the American Psychological Association (APA), contains more than 2 million citations and summaries of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertations, all in psychology and related disciplines, dating as far back as the 1800s. The database also includes information about the psychological aspects of related fields such as medicine, psychiatry, nursing, sociology, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, anthropology, business, law and others.

CQ Researcher : The CQ Researcher provides original, comprehensive reporting and analysis on issues shaping our world. Each 12,000-word report offers in-depth, non-biased coverage of political and social issues, with regular reports on topics in health, international affairs, education, the environment, technology, and the U.S. economy.
