Suggested [Catalog](#) Search Tips:

Try combining terms from the following...

Geographical areas: United States, Eastern Europe, Middle East, etc...

Time periods: 20th Century, Industrial Revolution, Middle Ages, etc...

Major events: French Revolution, Civil Rights Movement, etc...

People: George Washington, American-Indians, Women, African-Americans, Japanese, Gypsies, etc...

Library Databases:

[Research Databases](#) > Browse databases by name with the **A – Z List**

[Academic Search Premier](#): Contains articles from over 4,700 magazines and journals. This database covers many, many subjects (including history).

[New York Times Historical](#): Contains full-text and images of articles from 1851 – 2005. You can even limit your search to only articles that appeared on the front-page.

[PBS eVideo Collection](#): Over 200 full-length videos from acclaimed PBS programs, streamed to your computer.

Periodicals:

[History](#): A scholarly history journal, excluding classical history, but otherwise not limited to period, subject or geographical area. Coverage 1990 – Present (1 year delay). Available online via *EBSCOhost*.

[Journal of American History](#): The journal of the Organization of American Historians. Original articles, oral history and extensive numbers of book reviews on all aspects of American history. Coverage 2003 – Present. Available online via *EBSCOhost*.

[European Review of History](#): An international journal covering European history of all centuries and sub-disciplines. Coverage 1994 – Present (1 year delay). Available online via *EBSCOhost*.
