CPCC Fall Registration

If you have students that are still interested in attending CPCC that did not participate in the College Connection program, there is still time to get them registered for fall classes! The steps to enrollment are listed below. Please advise your students to complete these steps as soon as possible as fall classes are already filling up! Our fall semester begins August 4th.

Step 1: [Complete Admissions Application To CCCC](#) Within an hour, the student should receive an email with your Student ID Number.

Step 2: [Create Your CCCC Login \(Username And Password\)](#)

Step 3: [Set Up Your CCCC Student Email](#)

Step 4: [Complete FAFSA](#) to begin the [Financial Aid](#) process, if needed.

Step 5: Submit high school and external college [transcripts](#); then [have college transcripts evaluated](#), if applicable.

Step 6: Study For ACCUPLACER Placement Tests using the [ACCUPLACER Practice Tests And Review Videos](#). Then [take ACCUPLACER Placement Tests](#) The ACCUPLACER tests are now mandatory, but some students may qualify for a [test waiver](#).

Step 7: [Sign Up For Orientation](#) and attend Orientation to complete the enrollment steps, be advised on classes and programs, and learn how to register

Step 8: Register and pay for classes, or confirm that you have a Financial Aid award by the [Payment Due Date](#)

FAFSA Assistance and Scholarship Applications

Students that need assistance in completing their FAFSA can utilize one of the many resources that CCCC offers. On our website we have great step-by-step resources available by clicking [here](#). We also hold FAFSA days every Thursday on our Central Campus in CH113 in one hour sessions at 9, 10, and 11am through July 12. After July 12, the sessions will be moved to Fridays. Parents (or students) can walk-in during those times for personal assistance from our Financial Aid staff.

In addition to the FAFSA we encourage all students to complete our CCCC scholarship application; it is a very simple online application that only takes a few minutes to submit. Engineering Summer Camp for rising 9th-12th graders

CCCC will host several one-week sessions of engineering camp this summer for rising 9th-12th graders. This camp is designed to introduce students to science and engineering concepts and principles. The camp will provide participants a deeper understanding of how math, science and engineering converge and complement each other through “contextual learning” activities and projects. Participants will build, analyze, and test their own machines like the quadcopter while learning fundamental concepts of electrical, mechanical, and computer engineering disciplines.
