



Easy Steps for Enrollment

Enrollment at CPCC is quick and easy. Here is how to get the process rolling:

- Complete an online application found by going to www.cpcc.edu/enroll
You will be prompted to select a major (Fire Protection Technology Program Code: A55240)
Be sure to confirm your residency status
Make sure to complete the form in its entirety
- Create your CPCC login so that you can access your student records and email accounts at <https://secure2.cpcc.edu/cpcclogin>
You will need your CPCC student identification number to activate your login. Please memorize your user name and password. You will need both to access your account, register for classes, pay tuition, access grades and to take online classes.
- Request previous college and/or high school transcripts. All information can be found at <http://www.cpcc.edu/admissions/student-records/transcripts?searchterm=transcripts>
- Schedule an appointment to take the placement test at any CPCC campus.
Make sure you review the Accuplacer Study Guide - on the CPCC website, type 'placement test prep' in the search box to bring up all the testing information links – as retests are generally not permitted.
Please bring a picture ID with you to the testing center
If you have completed college level English and Math courses with a grade of "C" or better, you may not need to take the placement test.
