### Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for enrollment, a high school student must meet the following criteria:

- a. Be a high school junior or senior;
- b. Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 on high school courses or have the recommendation of the high school principal or his/her designee; and
- c. Meet the testing requirements for the career pathway (if applicable).

Note: This program is designed so that HSC 110 and 140 will be taken in the first semester and HEA 112 and MED 121 will be taken prior to the remainder of the courses.
