Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for enrollment, a high school student must meet the following criteria:

- a. Be a high school junior or senior;
- b. Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 on high school courses or have the recommendation of the high school principal or his/her designee; and
- c. Meet the testing requirements for the career pathway (if applicable).

Note: This program is designed so that HSC 110 and 140 will be taken in the first semester and HEA 112 and MED 121 will be taken prior to pharmacy courses.
