## APPLICATION RANKING PROCESS

Applicants to the Associate in Applied Science degree in Cosmetology are selected on a “best prepared” basis. The point system is an objective means of assessing applicants to the Cosmetology Program. Applicants are ranked based upon points earned, and the students with the highest number of points will be selected each year. If two or more students have the identical point count total, the date of application submission will be the determining factor. It is in the student’s best interest to achieve as many ranking points as possible. The components of the ranking system include the following:

**1. Related Courses**

Points are awarded for specific course grades completed by the application deadline. Grade points are valued as follows: A= 3 points, B= 2 points and C= 1 point. Related academic courses are listed below. Only courses completed by the deadline will be used for ranking. Courses must be completed with a “C” or higher. Unofficial copies of transcripts, with courses highlighted, must be attached to the application for verification.
