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Filers who believe they are victims of identity theft do not need to be referred to the Identity Protection Specialized Unit (IPSU); they may call the toll-free number (800-908-4490) directly or go to the ID theft website at www.irs.gov. After the IPSU authenticates the tax filer's identity, the tax filer can request that the IRS mail to the tax filer an alternate paper tax return transcript. The alternate transcript is known as the TRDBV (Transcript Data Base View).

Note: Tax filers may inform the IRS of the tax-related identity theft and obtain a TRDBV transcript by calling the IRS's Identity Protection Specialized Unit (IPSU) at 1-800-908-4490. Tax filers who cannot obtain a TRDBV transcript may instead submit another official IRS transcript or equivalent document provided by the IRS if it includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified or a signed copy of the tax return. Unless the institution has reason to suspect the authenticity of the TRDBV transcript or an equivalent document provided by the IRS, a signature or stamp or any other validation from the IRS is not needed.
