

CCP College Ready Pathway (P9099A)

Important Pathway Information

The CCP Career and College Ready Pathway offers high school students career exploration and college preparatory coursework, facilitating their transition to college.

Students who complete the required supplemental coursework may qualify for any approved CCP Pathway.

Eligibility

Beginning in Fall 2026, high school students who are rising juniors and above are eligible to choose this pathway. Students may select an additional CTE pathway that does not have a GPA requirement.

Required Supplemental Courses

This course selection encompasses supplementary coursework that prepares students for gateway mathematics and English courses aligned with the student's chosen academic and career pathway.

English Composition

Students who satisfy college readiness criteria are exempt from supplemental English courses

Students who satisfy college readiness criteria are exempt from supplemental Math courses

MAT 025 Concepts of Essential Math (3 credits) – Readiness skills for MAT 143 and MAT 152
