Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for enrollment, a high school student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a high school junior or senior
- Have an unweighted GPA of 2.8 or greater or Benchmark test scores
- Classes meet Mon – Thu 2:30p – 9:30p (Monday is virtual/online with the instructor during class time)
- Summer classes required: COS 115 and 116
