Non-IRS Tax Filers and Non-Foreign Nation Tax Filers

If you are the contributor of a dependent student or you are an independent student, did not file a federal tax return, and your financial aid file is selected for verification, you are required to submit an IRS Verification of Non-filing letter. If you were living in a different country during the 2022 tax year, you must provide documentation similar to that of the IRS from the tax authority you were subject to. If you are unable to obtain documentation similar to that of the IRS from a foreign tax authority after making a good faith effort to obtain it, the Financial Aid office will accept a signed statement for non-filing and non-IRS tax filers by the student and/or contributor if the student or contributor:

- attempted to obtain a Verification of Non-filing letter from the IRS and its equivalent from a Foreign Tax Authority;
- was unable to obtain the required documentation; and
- has not filed, and is not required to file, a 2023 income tax return.

Additionally, the student and/or contributor needs to provide:

- a list of all income sources earned in 2023, and the amount of income from each source;
- a copy of an IRS-issued W-2 (that has the employer's EIN#) or the equivalent from a Foreign Nation for each source of earned

income from work. This will be used to verify the amount of the income earned.

Dependent students who are non-tax filers do not need to submit a signed statement stating they were unable to obtain confirmation from the IRS that they did not file taxes.
