

Pre-Medical Assisting

Admission to the Medical Assisting program is competitive. The program admits 24 students each for the fall and spring semesters. Students must complete a separate admission application when they are ready to apply to the Medical Assisting program. It's recommended that students consider all of the following to improve their application

REQUIRED:

1. Attend Medical Assisting information session

OPTIONAL:

1. Points on application will be added for current CPR certification from American Red Cross or Heart Association
2. Points on application will be added for successful completion of HSC 110 or HSC 140
3. It is highly recommended that students complete general education courses before applying to the program, *but it is not a requirement*. Many general education courses receive points on the application. The more courses completed, the stronger your application. Once an eligible course is completed with a C grade or better, it will give you points on your application. A recommended course schedule is:
