

Pre-Medical Laboratory Technology

Admission to the Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) program is competitive. The program admits a maximum of 24 students for the fall semester. Students must complete a separate admission application when they are ready to apply to the MLT program. It's recommended that students consider all of the following to improve their application

REQUIRED:

1. All applicants must take the TEAS exam. An overall TEAS score minimum of 60 is recommended for admissions into the MLT program. For information and/or scheduling for the TEAS, please access:

OPTIONAL:

1. Attend Medical Laboratory Technology information session
2. Points on application are awarded for related work experience of at least 6 months in the last 5 years. Work experience can be directly related to the clinical laboratory, related to labs in general but not medical, or non-lab experience as a healthcare worker.
3. It is highly recommended that students complete general education courses before applying to the program, *but it is not a requirement*. Many general education courses receive points on the application. The more courses completed, the stronger your application. Once an eligible course is completed with a C grade or better, it will give you points on your application. A recommended course sequence is the following:
