

Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)- Accelerated ADN Option Pre-Admission Guide (A45110A)

Admission to the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)- Accelerated ADN option is competitive. The program admits 24 students each summer semester. Students must complete a separate admission application when applying to the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)-Accelerated ADN option.

It is highly recommended that students not work while in this program due to the accelerated programs' fast course pace. Students are in class or clinical for an average of 32-37 hours per week.

The Accelerated ADN option has a competitive admissions process and seats are limited. To be considered for this program, applicants must have completed all the general education requirements for the program and meet the following criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 3.3 or higher in prerequisite coursework.
- Grade of “B” or better in BIO 168 and BIO 169 class and lab.
- Only one grade of “C” or below in which applicant retook a prerequisite course to receive a higher grade to apply.
- All official transcripts demonstrating general education courses must be submitted with application to be considered.
- Must be 18 years of age or older prior to the start of the first clinical rotation.
- The applicant must be a certified Nurse Aide I and listed on the NC Nurse Aide Registry without restrictions before the first class begins.
- Due to the fast nature of the program, applicants will also be required to have a current BLS for Healthcare Providers card and keep the certificate active while in the nursing program.

Only students meeting the requirements above will be considered for admission. Each admission cycle, the top applicants are selected based on the highest scores for that admission period.
