

Pharmacy Technology Program Pre Admission Guide

Admission to the Pharmacy Technology program is competitive. The program admits 20 students each year for the fall semester. Students must complete a separate admission application when they are ready to apply to the Pharmacy Technology program. It's recommended that students consider all of the following to improve their application:

REQUIRED:

1. Attend a Pharmacy Technology information session or Open House.

OPTIONAL:

1. Points on application are awarded for prior pharmacy technician work including earned CPhT, graduate of certificate program or 40 hrs. of work experience as a Pharmacy Technician
2. It is highly recommended that students complete general education courses before applying to the program, **but it is not a requirement**. Some of general education courses receive points on the application. The more courses completed, the stronger your application. Once an eligible course is completed with a C grade or better, it will give you points on your application. A recommended course schedule is:
