Refugee	• Departure or Arrival Departure Record (Form I94/Form I94A) stamped as refugee under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) or "209a pending. Employment Authorized;" or • U.S. Travel Documents (Form I-571) with stamp "Permit to Reenter."

Asylee	• Departure or Arrival Departure Record (Form I94/Form I-94A) stamped as Asylee under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) or “209a pending. Employment Authorized;” or • U.S. Travel Document (Form I-571) with stamp “Permit to Reenter.”
Parolee	• Departure or Arrival Departure Record (Form I-94/Form I-94A) with stamp indicating “Alien paroled into the U.S. pursuant to Section 212(d)(5) ...”
Victim of Human Trafficking, or Spouse, Child, Parent of Victim	• Victim must submit certification letter from the Department Health and Human Services Spouse, Child or (HHS). Spouse, child or parent of victim must submit a copy of the victim’s certification Parent of Victim letter and a copy of their T-visa.
